- Confirmation numbers for reservations

- Cash or Travelers checks
- TSA approved locks
- Mark all equipment clearly
- Keep cameras, computers and all other electrical components cool and dry and in a protected case (i.e. Pelican case, camera bag)

NOTES:

Remember 3-1-1 (all liquids or gels are 3 oz or less, in a 1 quart ziplock bag, 1 bag per person in carry on luggage) and don't forget the weight limits on luggage.
